Introduction

This document is a companion to the [Aikido Victoria Training Fee Subscriptions and Online Payments Guide](#). Please refer to the general guide for instructions on how to use the payments platform.

The contents of this document specifically describe dojo training fee subscriptions for students, staff/alumni and community members training at Monash University Dojo only. Aiki Kai Australia membership, and training fees for events or dojo training at other venues are separate and described elsewhere.

Membership and Training Fees

To join the Monash University Aikido Club, students must:

- Join on UniOne (Connected Communities): [Monash Aikido Club](#) - this is free of charge. Students will use their UniOne account, staff and alumni sign up with an email address.
- Sign up for Aikido Australia Membership:
 - [Student](#) – University memberships can be paid either per semester or annually.
 - [Staff/Alumni](#) - Choose the appropriate membership level for you.
- Pay (Dojo) Training Fees – depending on whether you are a student, staff/alumni or community member, different training fees apply.

While membership and training fees are separate, both must be paid for you to train. This guide only covers the dojo training fees.

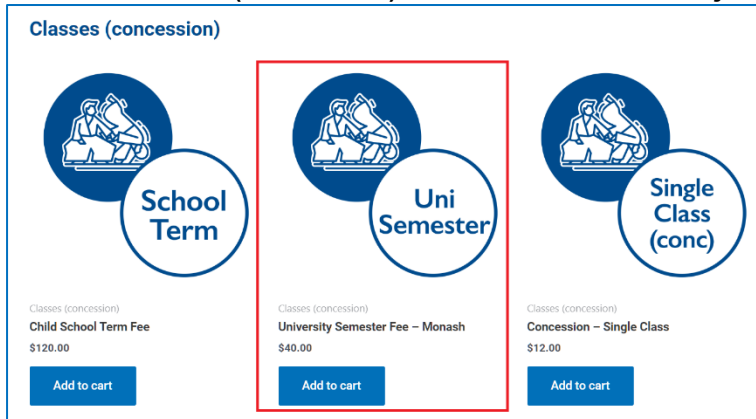
Monash University Dojo Training Fees

<p>Current Monash Student</p>	<p>Semester Training Fee</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entitles you to train at Monash University dojo only • Train as much as you like (Tuesday and Thursday classes) • Lasts approximately 10 weeks, including semester breaks • Semester 1: from O-Week (February) to start of Semester 2 classes (July) • Semester 2: from start of Semester 2 classes (July) to first weekend of December (Aikido Victoria December TTC)
<p>Monash Staff/Alumni Community Member (neither a Monash student/staff/alumni)</p>	<p>Aikido Victoria Dojo Training Subscription</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entitles you to train at any Aikido Victoria dojo (including Monash University) • Daily/Weekly/Monthly/3 Monthly/6 Monthly subscriptions available • Concession rates apply if eligible • Limited spots for non-students available – please check with instructors before coming

Training subscription rates are published on the payments platform.

Setting up a Semester Subscription

1. Go to the Aikido Victoria online payments platform: <https://aikidomelbourne.org.au/store/>
2. Under the **Classes (Concession)** section, find the **University Semester Fee – Monash** icon.



3. Click **Add to cart**.
4. Scroll to the top of the screen and click on the shopping trolley to checkout.
5. Follow the instructions on the screen to complete the subscription and payment.

Note: Like all other training subscriptions, you can only purchase one subscription at a time. To make it easier, we recommend purchasing your training subscription in a separate transaction to any other payments (eg: events).

Fees for Events (Special Days of Training, TTCs, National Schools, etc)

There is no separate Monash Uni rate for events. Monash students should purchase the appropriate training fee for the event. If you are eligible for concession rates (eg: have a student ID card or other concession card holder), you may purchase training at the concession rate.

Please make sure you select the right one from the payments platform.

FAQs

What are the differences between the types of training fees?

	Student Semester Training Fee	Aikido Victoria Training Subscription
Who can purchase	Monash students only – student ID may be requested	Anyone (including Monash students)
Dojo Training	Training at Monash Uni dojo only (Tuesdays and Thursdays)	Train at any Aikido Victoria dojo, any day, as many times as you like
TRAKR attendance app	Payment status does not show in TRAKR Email receipt must be shown to instructor before training	Payment status shows in TRAKR
Ability to cancel	Yes	Yes
Ability to suspend	No	Yes

I am a Monash Uni student, am I only allowed to purchase the semester training?

No – you can purchase any type of training subscription you like. It's up to you to decide which one fits how you want to train.

I'm a Monash student and I want to train at other dojos as well as Monash Uni.

If you have purchased the semester training fee, you must also pay the standard Aikido Victoria training fee to train at any of our other dojos. However, you do not need to pay a separate Aikido Australia membership fee.

If you plan to train other dojos regularly, it may be more cost effective to purchase a standard training subscription since that allows you to train at any of our Victorian dojos, including Monash. As a student, you would also likely qualify for the concession rate. It's completely up to you to decide how you want to train.

I won't be able to train for the whole semester. What should I do?

Have a look at the other subscriptions, including daily classes. One of these may work out better for your personal situation. If in doubt, ask one of the instructors.

I am a student, but not at Monash Uni. Can I purchase the semester training?

Currently, no. This is an arrangement specifically for Monash Uni students. Please purchase another type of training subscription.
